







(*1) **RGB DIY**:


- 1. Press FN + ~ (DIY) to activate RGB customization.
- 2. Press FN + \sim (DIY) again, and the LED indication (A) & (1) will flash at the same time.
- 3. There are 9 backlight color modes (including backlight off) to select. Keep pressing the key you would like to customize the RGB backlight color.
- 4. Press FN + ~ (DIY) again to complete the customization setting.

Instructions

■ Connecting to your PC

- a. Connect the keyboard to the PC using the USB C to USB A cable.
- b. The keyboard will be detected by Windows within 5-30 seconds.
- c. The keyboard is now ready for use.

★: USB connection (blue LED)



Troubleshooting

Unable to detect keyboard on PC

- Make sure the computer meets the minimum system requirements.
- Try connecting the keyboard to a different USB port on the computer to ensure that the USB cable isn't damaged and is correctly plugged in.
- If the issue persists, enter your computer's settings and make sure the keyboard language is set to match the product's configuration.

Hot swappable keyboard switches



- a. Take off key caps with a keycap puller.
- b. Pull out the switch with a switch puller.
- c. Ensure the shaft of the switch is correctly aligned with the socket.
- d. Accurately place the new switch on the socket.
- e. Gently press the switch into the socket.
- f. Install the key cap back onto the switch.
